Grassroots Movement Gains Momentum in Opposition to New Administration

Together We Will USA (TWW) is a quickly expanding national grassroots organization with more than 350,000 members around the nation--from Virginia to Kentucky, Colorado and California. In all 71 percent of our members are new to activism.

TWW members are committed to defending and advancing democracy and human rights as well as working to conserve and protect the environment and resources for future generations.

We will execute this mission through coordinated actions across the United States. TWW leaders, in both red and blue states, began volunteering their time after the 2016 election to bring together like-minded groups and organizations and maximize impact. Our members are organized in state and city chapters under the umbrella of a national group. Most of our volunteers are working full time jobs, raising families (or both) while taking political action in our free time.

Actions we are taking include non-violent marches, protests, rallies, unified efforts to contact lawmakers of both parties, digital campaigns to spread our message, and providing resources to train new leaders who will fight for true democracy in America.

TWW has partnered with a wide range of organizations, from the ACLU in Northern California to Indivisible local groups, local women's marches and groups defending refugee rights.

TWW members are standing up against the current administration's continued disregard for the basic human rights and constitutional rights of people in our communities.

Here's a sample of what our TWW chapters are doing across the country:

- *TWW Richmond, Virginia (TWWRVA) has developed a comprehensive website to organize local action and highlight organizations they are fundraising for. This group, which includes almost 13,000 members, recently celebrated a victory when a local congressman was recorded in a private meeting saying “these women are in my grill.”*
- *TWW Long Beach is organizing a calendar to ensure local representatives get regular visits from constituents. The group is also working on an online map to document successes of the movement and is in the planning stages of a video campaign.*
- *TWW Bluegrass is focusing on Kentucky state politics and working hand in hand with the Kentucky Democratic party to research and monitor legislation. The group also helps raise funds for local charities.*
- *TWW North Carolina’s main goal is community building. The group is committed to fighting the racially-prejudiced gerrymandering in the state.*
